### Flexible Course for Credit\*

(Grades 8-12)

This course is taught entirely with live teachers at Sylvan! Proficiency based, these classes move at the student's pace of understanding; we require 80% proficiency or above in order to keep moving ahead. Accredited by Cognia, courses available are: Algebra 1 & 2, Advanced Algebra 2, Geometry, Functions, Stats, and Trig Pre Calculus, Calculus, College Prep Studies (SAT&ACT), Creative Writing Literature and Composition 9-12, English 9-12, and various Study Skills Electives.

### AP Course for Credit\*

(Grades 10-12)

Choose from over 20 AP options; these courses include a high school AP credit and prepare students to take the (optional) May AP test for potential college credit. Powered by our partner, Columbia Learning, students access their asynchronous learning portal online ~4 hours/week and have weekly support sessions with expert Sylvan teachers. Additional homework time is expected for these high-level courses!

### Set-Term Course for Credit\*

(Grades 9-12)

Runs on an 18-week (.5 credit) or 36-week (1.0 credit) calendar syncing closely with the district semester terms. This program is available at a cost-efficient price point and is powered by our partner, Columbia Learning. The course is taught in an asynchronous online learning platform 4 hours a week; a 5<sup>th</sup> (or more!) hour each week dedicated to Sylvan teacher support to keep students on track with and engaged in his/her material. Additional support hours available, if needed. Over 100 course options available!

*\*All Monthly membership classes are month-to-month subscriptions. Excused absences must be used within each calendar week.*

### Personalized Tutoring

(Grades PreK-College)

Sylvan's personal approach in math, reading, writing, homework support and study skills can set your child up for success throughout the school year and for life. Our hours are flexible and programs are developed based on your personal needs and goals. For enrichment or remediation, allow our expert, licensed teachers to help your child grasp concepts in a supportive and focused environment.

### SAT or ACT Prep

(Grades 10-12)
